SHORT-FORM AGREEMENT - ATP FINALS BY & BETWEEN FEDERAZIONE ITALIANA TENNIS AND ATP TOUR, INC.

This Agreement, dated April 11, 2019, states the principal terms of an agreement between Federazione Italiana Tennis ("FIT") and ATP Tour, Inc. ("ATP"), with respect to the operation and staging of the ATP Finals in Turin, Italy, from 2021 through 2025.

- 1. <u>Background</u>. ATP is the worldwide sanctioning body for the men's professional tennis circuit known as the "ATP Tour" and is the owner of the ATP Finals, the year-end championship of the ATP Tour (the "ATPF"). FIT has bid for the right to host the ATPF in Turin, Italy, pursuant to the bid documents it has submitted to ATP (namely, the ATP Finals 2021+ Bid Application Manual and the ATP Finals 2021+ Bid Guide) attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> (the "FIT Bid Documents"). FIT and ATP desire to enter into this agreement whereby the ATPF would be conducted at the Pala Alpitour in Turin, Italy (the "Venue"), from 2021 through 2025.
- 2. <u>Condition Precedent</u>. This Agreement shall be entirely conditioned upon FIT establishing the letter of credit required pursuant to Section 4(c) below no later than April 15, 2019. In the event the above listed condition is not met on or before April 15, 2019, this Agreement shall terminate and be of no force or effect and neither party shall have any claim against the other in relation to this Agreement. For the avoidance of doubt, the condition set out in this Section shall be a condition precedent to the effectiveness and validity of this Agreement.

3. Operation / Exploitation of the ATPF.

- Operational Obligations. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, ATP hereby grants FIT the right and FIT accepts and agrees to the obligation of staging the ATPF at the Venue during the Term (as defined in Section 6(a) below) in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the 2019 ATP Official Rulebook as amended from time to time (the "ATP Rules"), the direction of ATP and all of the commitments, representations, agreements and warranties made in the FIT Bid Documents, which are incorporated into this Agreement by this reference as if fully set forth herein. It is understood that in the case of a conflict between the ATP Rules and the FIT Bid Documents, the provisions of the ATP Rules shall prevail with respect to (i) those items set forth in Section 3(c) below, (ii) any rule which all ATP tournaments must comply with, or (iii) any rule change mutually agreed by the parties; otherwise the FIT Bid Documents shall prevail. Further, except as otherwise provided for in the FIT Bid Documents, FIT shall be solely responsible for any and all costs and expenses related to the staging of the ATPF at the Venue during the Term. FIT agrees to provide the Venue and all aspects of the operation of the ATPF in accordance with, and subject to, the FIT Bid Documents. Finally, FIT acknowledges and agrees that all other aspects of the ATPF, including but not limited commercial exploitation, shall be as set forth in the FIT Bid Documents. FIT shall have the option to change the location, subject to the approval of ATP's Board of Directors (such approval or disapproval shall be in the sole discretion of ATP's Board of Directors), provided that the request to change the Venue must be submitted to ATP Board no later than 18 months in advance of such proposed location change.
- (b) No ATP Membership / Retention of Rights. FIT acknowledges that no ATP tournament class membership or other rights are being granted to FIT and FIT shall have no other rights in respect of or in connection with the ATPF except as provided in this Agreement. Subject to the rights granted to FIT in this Agreement, ATP shall, at all times, retain all rights with respect to the ATPF. FIT

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acknowledges and agrees that, upon expiration or termination of this Agreement for any reason, all rights granted to FIT herein shall revert to ATP.

ATP's Obligation. In the event that, during the Term, ATP substantively modifies (i) the ATPF's competition format (as currently set forth in sections 4.01 (A) and 4.02 (A) of the 2019 ATP Official Rulebook), (ii) the provisions relating to player participation in the ATPF (as currently set forth in section 4.01 (B) and 4.02 (B) of the 2019 ATP Official Rulebook) and/or (iii) the actual scheduling of ATPF (i.e., a 7-8 day event scheduled at the conclusion of the ATP Tour Calendar), and that in the reasonable opinion of FIT the modification will have a significant negative impact on the financial viability of the ATPF, then ATP and FIT shall in good faith negotiate to determine if certain terms and conditions of the Agreement should be adjusted in order protect and safeguard their respective interests. In this case, if any substantive modifications to the rules mentioned above in (i), (ii) and (iii) are to be proposed to ATP's Board of Directors, ATP agrees to first consult with FIT on such rule change proposals in advance. In the event the good faith negotiations noted above do not result in an amendment to this Agreement which meets with FIT's reasonable satisfaction, ATP may propose such rule change to the ATP's Board of Directors and the ATP's Board of Directors may approve such rule change, provided however, such rule change will not take effect until 18 months after being approved by ATP's Board of Directors. ATP shall promptly notify FIT of any such approved rule change. FIT may terminate this Agreement by providing ATP written notice no later than 28 days after being notified in writing by ATP that such rule change has been approved by ATP's Board of Directors, such termination shall not be effective until December 31 of the year in which the last ATPF occurs immediately preceding the date the relevant rule change comes into effect. However, in the event ATP retracts the relevant rule change within 60 days of receipt of FIT's notice, this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

4. Financial Terms.

- (a) Annual Player Prize Money. FIT agrees to pay ATP the following prize money amounts each year: US\$14,500,000 for the 2021 ATPF, US\$14,750,000 for the 2022 ATPF, US\$15,000,000 for the 2023 ATPF, US\$15,250,000 for the 2024 ATPF and US\$15,500,000 for the 2025 ATPF. ATP shall remit such amounts each year to the participating players of the ATPF in accordance with the ATP Rules. Such amounts shall be paid to ATP in three equal installments on or before April 30, July 30 and October 30 of each year during the Term in which the applicable ATPF will be played, commencing in 2021, and shall be paid via wire transfer in Euros (based on the published exchange rate in the Wall Street Journal on January 1 of each applicable year) without any deductions or withholdings of any kind to a bank account designated by ATP. FTT agrees to be solely responsible for calculating and remitting (on or before the 15 December after the conclusion of each ATPF during the Term) the required Italian tax withholdings on prize money each year and ATP, for 2021, shall reimburse FTT for such amounts in advance of FTT's payment deadline each year during the Term, provided FTT notifies ATP of such payment amounts at least 15 days prior to the payment deadline; after the 2021 ATPF, ATP and FTT shall review and agree upon the most effective method to have the required Italian tax withholdings remitted in a manner which will prevent any significant cash flow issues for FTT.
- (b) <u>ATP License Fee</u>. Subject to the terms herein, in consideration of the rights granted to FIT herein, FIT agrees to pay ATP a license fee of US\$17,500,000 in each of 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025. Such amounts shall be paid to ATP on or before February 15 of each year during the Term, commencing in 2021, and shall be paid via wire transfer in Euros (based on the published exchange rate in the Wall Street Journal on January 1 of each applicable year) without any deductions or withholdings of any kind to a bank account designated by ATP.
- (c) <u>Letter of Credit</u>. As security for the payments to be made hereunder, FIT shall cause to be delivered to ATP on or before April 15, 2019, and shall maintain in effect throughout the Term, an

irrevocable and unconditional standby letter of credit in favor of ATP in the amount of €44,000,000 (provided that the amount of such letter of credit may be reduced to €28,600,000 on December 31, 2024; and further provided that so long as ATP has received the final license fee payment, the amount of such letter of credit may be reduced to €15,500,000 on March 3, 2025), which shall expire no earlier than December 31, 2025. Such letter of credit shall be issued by a bank acceptable to ATP and shall be in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B.

ATP shall have the right to draw on the letter of credit in the event FIT fails to make any payment to be made hereunder within 17 days of being notified in writing by ATP that such payment is late (for the purposes of the notice required, an email shall be sufficient). In this event, ATP shall have the right to draw on the letter of credit up to an amount equal to the payment which FIT failed to pay. Once ATP makes such partial draw on the letter of credit, FIT shall be obligated to replenish the letter of credit up to its full amount no later than 20 days after ATP makes such draw, in which case this Agreement will remain in full force and effect. However, in the event FIT fails to replenish the letter of credit within such time period, ATP shall have the right to terminate this Agreement and draw on the letter of credit for its full remaining amount.

In addition, ATP shall have the right to draw on the letter of credit in full in the event (i) FIT is subject to any of the insolvency events set forth in Section 5 (d) below, (ii) FIT fails to operate the ATPF in any year during the Term for any reason other than a force majeure event as defined Section 6(e) below.

Furthermore, in the event FIT does not operate the ATPF substantially in accordance with the budget submitted by FIT in the FIT Bid Documents for 2021 (such budget being developed to conduct the ATPF in a first-class manner), or FIT does not operate the ATPF substantially in accordance with the mutually approved budget for any year thereafter (in the event the parties cannot agree on a budget in any year, the prior year's budget will be considered the approved budget for such year) FIT shall pay to ATP the penalty set forth below. For the purposes of this section "substantially in accordance with the budget" shall mean that FIT spent at least 80% of the full total budgeted amount for the relevant year (for the avoidance of doubt, neither the license fee, the prize money amounts, nor the VAT taxes on tickets sales, shall be considered in the calculation of the full total budget in any year). If FIT does not operate the ATPF substantially in accordance with the budget, FIT shall pay to ATP a penalty equal to the budgeted amount not spent by FIT. If FIT fails to make the penalty payment within 17 days of being notified in writing by ATP (for the purposes of the notice required, an email shall be sufficient) ATP shall have the right to draw on the letter of credit up to an amount equal to the penalty payment which FIT failed to pay. Once ATP makes such partial draw on the letter of credit, FIT shall be obligated to replenish the letter of credit up to its full amount no later than 20 days after ATP makes such draw, in which case this Agreement will remain in full force and effect. However, in the event FIT fails to replenish the letter of credit within such time period, ATP shall have the right to terminate this Agreement and draw on the letter of credit for its full remaining amount. FIT agrees to keep accurate and complete books and records showing all budgeted expenditures each year and to provide such records, certified to be accurate by an officer or FIT, to ATP as soon as reasonably possible after each ATPF during the Term.

In the event ATP has the right to draw on the letter of credit in full as provided for in this Section 4(c), FIT acknowledges and agrees that ATP shall have the right to (x) draw and retain, as liquidated damages and not as a penalty, up to the full amount of the letter of credit, (y) use the funds from the letter of credit to conduct the ATPF in a location of ATP's sole selection, and (z) terminate this Agreement. The parties acknowledge and agree that in the event ATP is entitled to draw on the letter of credit, the actual damages ATP would suffer are difficult to predict and would be difficult or impossible to calculate, and that any amount drawn by ATP from the letter of credit would be a fair measure of ATP's damages and would be deemed liquidated damages and not a penalty.

5. Term and Termination.

- (a) Subject to Sections 5(b), 5(c) and 5(d) below, and Section 2 above, this Agreement shall become effective upon execution hereof and shall expire on December 31, 2025 (the "Term").
- (b) In the event of a material breach of this Agreement by either party, this Agreement may be earlier terminated at the option of the non-breaching party, upon 20 days prior written notice of termination to the breaching party that describes the alleged breach in reasonable detail, unless such breach is cured within such 20 day period; provided however, if such breach occurs within 20 days prior to the commencement of any ATPF or during any ATPF, this Agreement may be earlier terminated at the option of the non-breaching party, upon 24 hours prior written notice of termination to the breaching party that describes the alleged breach in reasonable detail, unless such breach is cured within such 24 hour period, and further provided that such termination shall not become effective until 30 days after the ATPF with respect to which the uncured breach occurred.
- (c) In the event ATP determines in its sole discretion that the quality of any ATPF during the Term is not being operated in a first-class manner (the "Quality Standard"), ATP shall notify FIT in & writing that states in detail the substantive issues which in ATP's opinion caused the relevant ATPF to fall below the Quality Standard. ATP and FIT shall then meet to discuss the substantive issues which caused the relevant ATPF to fall below the Quality Standard and the remedies which, in ATP's opinion, need to be put in place at the next edition of the ATPF to ensure it meets the Quality Standard. In the event FIT fails to implement such remedies at the next edition of the ATPF, ATP shall have the right to terminate this Agreement by providing 20 days written notice to FIT within 60 days after the conclusion of such edition of the ATPF.
- (d) Notwithstanding the Term set forth in Section 5(a) above, either party may terminate this Agreement effective upon written notice to the other in the event of (i) the other's insolvency or adjudication of bankruptcy (or similar proceeding under applicable law), (ii) the filing of a petition for voluntary bankruptcy (or similar proceeding under applicable law) of the other or the filing of a petition for involuntary bankruptcy (or similar proceeding under applicable law) of the other if such involuntary petition is not dismissed within 60 days after its filing, (iii) the other's making of an arrangement with, or an assignment for the benefit of, creditors (or any similar arrangement or proceeding under applicable law) or (iv) the appointment of a receiver or trustee for the assets of the other (or similar proceeding under applicable law).

6. Miscellaneous Provisions.

- (a) Each party agrees to indemnify and hold the other and any of its affiliates, officers, directors, employees and agents harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees and litigation expenses) incurred by an indemnified party, affiliate or other person resulting from such party's non-performance or breach of its obligations hereunder or breach of any warranties or representations hereunder. FIT shall obtain and maintain, from reputable, internationally recognized insurers, the appropriate customary insurance policies for the conduct of a world class sporting event and shall have ATP named as an additional insured under such policies. FIT shall provide ATP with evidence of such insurance coverage upon request.
- (b) Both parties agree that nothing in this Agreement shall give a party any title to or ownership interest in the other party's intellectual property (including, without limitation, trademarks) and that upon expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement, all rights to such intellectual property (including, without limitation, trademarks) shall revert to their owner. Each party agrees not to raise or

cause to be raised any questions concerning or challenges to the other party's ownership of or the validity or registrability of the other party's intellectual property (including, without limitation, trademarks).

- (c) FIT acknowledges that ATP does not have the right to use the name, signature, photograph or likeness of any ATP player or member in connection with a commercial product or service unless so authorized by the player or member. FIT agrees that it will not exercise the rights granted in this Agreement in any manner that might appear to constitute a commercial endorsement by any ATP player or member without having obtained proper advance written authorization from ATP or directly from such player or member.
- (d) This Agreement does not constitute the parties hereto as partners or joint venturers, and nothing contained herein shall create any partnership or joint venture. The relationship of the parties hereto to each other is that of independent contractors, and neither party has the right to obligate or bind the other party in any manner whatsoever.
- (e) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Agreement, in the event the performance of this Agreement by FIT is prevented by an act of God or natural disaster outside the control of FIT, and any ATPF is cancelled by the parties after consultation in good faith, due to such event, FIT shall be relieved of its duty to conduct such cancelled ATPF, including its duty to pay the Player Prize Money(amount for such ATPF as required by Section 4. In the event an ATPF is cancelled pursuant to this Section 6(e), the parties agree that such force majeure event shall not constitute a breach of this Agreement, however, the parties shall meet to determine in good faith whether this Agreement should be terminated. For the avoidance of doubt, the following shall not be considered an act of God or natural disaster hereunder: economic conditions in Italy, fluctuations in currency, the instability of banking institutions within Italy, the instability of any government agency or a change in key personnel of any government agency, or social unrest.
- (f) This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida applicable to contracts entered into and to be fully performed therein. In the event any suit, action or proceeding is brought by either party with respect to this Agreement, such action, suit or proceeding shall be exclusively brought in the federal courts located in Jacksonville, Florida, and both parties hereby accept and submit to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue (as proper and convenient) of such court for the purpose of any such action, suit or proceeding. Each party agrees to accept service of process by any means permitted by such courts and hereby waives all claims to the effect that such courts constitute an inconvenient forum.
- (g) The parties acknowledge and agree that they desire to conclude and enter into a more detailed subsequent contract as soon as practical; however, in the event no such subsequent contract is entered into between the parties, this Agreement shall serve as the agreement between the parties relative to the subject matter herein and shall be fully enforceable and binding upon the parties.
- (h) The parties agree to keep the terms and conditions of this Agreement strictly confidential and shall not disclose such terms and conditions to any third party (other than its attorneys, accountants and advisors as necessary). Further, the parties agree not to make any public announcement concerning this Agreement until all of the conditions of Section 2 have been met and not until after mutual agreement concerning the wording, timing and place of any such public announcement.
- (i) This Agreement, including this provision, may not be waived, modified or changed in any manner except by a writing signed by each of the parties hereto.

- (j) Except as specifically contemplated by this Agreement, the rights and obligations of a party hereunder shall not be assigned, transferred, sublicensed, delegated, encumbered or otherwise alienated without the prior written consent of the other party (which shall not be unreasonably withheld) however, ATP hereby consents to an assignment, sublicense, transfer or delegation by FIT to any of those entities listed in Part 3 Section A of the Bid Application Manual submitted by FIT as part of the FIT Bid Documents. No assignment, sublicense, transfer or delegation of a party's rights or obligations under this Agreement shall relieve such party from any of its obligations hereunder. Failure of a party to complain of any act or omission on the part of the other party shall not be deemed a waiver by either party of its rights under this Agreement. The waiver by any party of a breach of any provision of this Agreement by the other party shall not operate or be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach by such other party.
- (k) All notices or other communications required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be sufficiently given and received in all respects when personally delivered, when sent by guaranteed overnight courier service, or for the purposes of the notice requirement set forth in Section 4(c) above, via email, addressed as follows:
